## **Environmental Policy Statement**

All employees and sub-contractors will be provided with the necessary resources, equipment, information, instruction and training to fulfill the requirements of this policy.

The Proprietor has overall responsibility for all environmental matters and this policy has been endorsed by him and has his full support in its implementation. The operation of this policy and the associated procedures will be monitored and reviewed on a regular basis to ensure that they remain current and applicable to the activities of the business.
